GENERAL POLICY

SCOPE

Fugro Ground Geophysics, located in Perth Australia and Lima Peru, provides superior quality ground geophysical services to our clients worldwide. Fugro Instruments, a division of Fugro Ground Geophysics which is located in Sydney Australia, sells, rents and repairs geophysical data acquisition systems for local and international clients. This policy applies to all of Fugro Ground Geophysics' business activities and personnel.

OBJECTIVES

In support of this policy, Fugro Ground Geophysics will:

- **Define** practical means, in association with world, country, and state or provincial regulations, for understanding and minimising the impact of our activities on the environment;
- **Maintain** environmental management safeguards as an integral part of business operations to ensure environmental impacts are responsibly managed;
- **Educate** all employees and contractors in environmental management protection, prior to and during all work activities;
- **Establish** company environmental goals and measurable targets for protection of the environment that are consistent with existing industry and regulatory standards;
